

May in Anno Domini 1788

Monday 2nd June 1788 - The Town being Met, according to the foregoing Adjournment.

The Question was put, to see if the Town, would accept of Mr. Ebenezer Wood, as a Constable for the South Ward the present Year - in the stead of Mr. William Brown formerly chosen - and the 2^d Question pass'd in the Negative.

Then the Town, by their Vote dissolved this Meeting.

Resolved, and to Notify & Warn, all the Freeholders and other Inhabitants, of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified as the Law directs, to Vote in Town Affairs, to Meet, at the Meeting House, in s^d Town, on Monday the 7th Day of July next, at 4 Clock, Afternoon, on s^d Day - there and there.

Article 1st Do Choose a Moderator, & see if the Town will consent, to have their Taxes, gathered the present Year, by Collector, instead of Constable - and choose Person, to the s^d Office, Do or Advise

2^d Do see, if the Town, will choose, One or more Persons, to serve as Constables in s^d Town, the present Year, - Do or Advise

3rd Do see, if the Town, will Depute some Person or Persons, to appear in Behalf of the Town, and answer to James Moore, - in an Action, by him commenced, before Samuel Philips, Justice Esq^r at Weston, on the 15th of July Next, - Do, or Advise
