

July - Anno Domini 1788

Then the Town, by their Vote, granted the Collector, 3^d on the Pound, for gathering, the Taxes, the present Year.

Then Col^l Rice, & Cap^t Moore, were in Open Town Meeting, Sworn into Office.

2^d Then the Town chose M^r Thomas Walker, Constable for 1st Town, the present Year.

3^d The Question, being put, to see if the Town would choose, some Person to appear, in Behalf of 1st Town, in the Action of James Moore & his wife, 1st Town, — it pass'd in the Negative.

4th Pass'd over, for the present.

Then the Town, by their Vote, Ordred, certain of 5th their Constables, to receive Cap^t Gilbert Dench's, promissory Note, for M^r Isaac Gibbs Town Tax, & also, Ordred, their Treasurer, to receive 1st Security, & discharge the 1st Constable, the 1st Assessment.

6th The Town by Vote, Authoris'd their Treasurer, as express'd in the 1st Article.

Then the Town, by their Vote, dissolv'd the 1st Meeting.
