

1st OCTOBER, Anno Domini 1788

1st We E. are to Notify, & Warn, all the Freeholders, & other Inhabitants, of the Town, of Sudbury, qualified as the Law directs, to Vote in Town Affairs, & to Meet at the Meeting House, in 2^d Town, on Monday, the 27th Day of this instant October, at 1st Clock, Afternoon, on 3^d Day, then & there;

Article

1st To choose a Moderator, & bring in Town Debt & Credit.

2^d To see, if the Town, will grant to their Rev^d Minister his Salary, for the Year ensuing, & make Provision for the seasonable Collection of the same - Do or Adv. any other Way, on this Article, as the Town, shall think proper, when Mett.

3^d To see, if the Town, will Order, that a Cartway, leading thro' M^r Nathaniel Lovings Farm, to Gulph Meadow, be Opened, Agreeable to the Request of M^r John Clark, - Do or Adv. &c

4th To see, if the Town, will call upon their Committee chosen, for the Purpose of Selling Lancaster Old Road, or 30 Rod, Highway, - to make Report, to the Town, of their Doings, relative to the s^d Purpose, Or Do, or Adv. with regard, to s^d Road, as the Town, may think proper, when Mett.

5th To see, if the Town, will make Provision for the Rebuilding, or Repairing, the Wall, round the Burying Yard, Do or Adv. &c.

6th To see, if the Town, will Grant Money, to enable their Committee (chosen for the Purpose of examining into the Dispute, between this Town, & the Town of Needham, as to the support, of Hannah Johnson, & Children,) to fulfill their Trust, Do or Adv. &c.

7th To see, if the Town, will make Provision, for supplying their Rev^d Minister, with a Quantity of Wood, necessary for the Approaching Winter. Do or Adv. &c
