Article The Question, being put, to see, if the Town
would open, the Cut-bow way, mentioned, in
this Article: - it pass'd, in the Negative. " " "

4th Voted, to call the Committee, to Account
as to their Doings, relative to the Road
mentioned, in this Article: - Then after
some Debate, voted to pass over the Article,
for the Present. " " "

+ Voted, to choose a Committee, to view
the Burying Yard, & make Report, to the
5th Town what, is necessary, to be Done as to the
Rebuilding, or Repairing the Wall, round
the same, & also Voted, that this Comtee
should enquire, whether
an Addition, might be Obtain'd, at
the East End, of the S^d Yard: - The
Committee chosen, were, M^r John, May-
nard, Col^l Ezekiel Wood, & M^r Tho-
mas Walker. " " "
