Then the Question, was put, to see if the Town would, reconsider, their former Grants, for Schooling: & it passed in the Negative.

Then the Town, by their Vote, Ordered their Assessors, to make the Money, granted at this Meeting, in a Rate forthwith.

Then the Town, by their Vote, Dissolved this Meeting.

We the Asses, are to Notify & Warn, all the Freeholders, and other Inhabitants, of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified as the Law directs, to Vote in Town Affairs, to Meet, at the Meeting House, in 1st Town, on Monday, the 10th Day of November next, at 1 O'Clock, Afternoon, on 2^d Day, then & there.

1st To choose, a Moderator.

To see, if the Town, will appoint, a Committee, to settle, with the Rev^d Mr. Biglow, the Arrearages, or Depreciation of his Salary, granted him, by the Town, in Paper Currency, or do or act, any other Way, on this Article, as the Town, shall think proper, when Met.
