

2 November, Anno Domini 1788

4th The Question, being put, to see if the Town, would Discount, to L^d Pread, - the Rates mentioned in this Article: - it pass'd in the Negative.

Then Voted, to Adjourn, this Meeting for the space, of one Hour,

Then the Town reassembled this Meeting agreeable to adjournment: - and again took up the 4th Article: - and by Vote, Discounted, to L^d Jacob Pread, the Rates, mentioned in 2^d Article, being £ 40.. 6.. 4 - old Emission

Then the Town, (after some Alteration, on the subject, of Depreciation;) Voted an Addition of Two Persons, to the Three, formerly chosen, as a Committee of Settlement, with the Pres^t - Mr Biglow: - and William Price Esq^r & Moses Taft - were added.

Then Voted, to adjourn this Meeting, one fortnight, 2^d Clock, - then to meet, at the same place.

Sunday, Monday 24th November 1788

The Town, being Met, agreeable to the foregoing Adjournment.

Attended to their Committee's Report, relative, to the Depreciation, of Mr Biglow's Gallery, but previous, to calling for 2^d Report. Voted to request Mr Biglow's Attendance, by a Committee of 3. - and Mr James Hagner, Mr John Balcom, & Cap^t Samuel Knight were chosen.

Then Voted, to call upon the Committee, for their Report: - who Reported. - that the sum of £ 155. 10.. 9 - was Due to Mr Biglow, on the Depreciation of his Galleries, for the Years 1776, 1777, 1778, and half 1779
