Then the Question, was put, to see, if the Town, would accept, the 2^d Report:— and it pass'd in the Negative.

Then the Question, was put, to see, if the Town would grant, to Mr. Biglow, the sum, of £90.— and 25 Cords of Wood, Annually, so long as he remain'd, the Minister, of the Town:— As a Compensation, for the aforementioned Depreciation:— & it pass'd, in the Negative.

Then it was Voted, that the Committee, cast, the Depreciation, on the aforesaid Sallery:— at 9 Months, from the Grants.

Then the Town, reconsidered the Vote, immediately preceeding.

Then the Question, was again put, to see, if the Town would accept, the Committees Report:— & it again pass'd in the Negative.

Then the Question, was Again put, to see, if the Town, would Grant, the Aforesaid Sum, of £90.— and 25 Cords, of Wood, — & it again pass'd in the Negative.

Then the Question, was put, for a Dissolution, of this Meeting:— & it pass'd in the Negative.

Then the Question, was, Asked, — to see, if the Town, would Grant, £120.— to make up, the aforesaid Depreciation, & it pass'd, in the Affirmative.

Then the Question, was put, to see if the Town, would Order, the Above Grants, to be made, into a Rate forthwith, & it pass'd, in the Affirmative.

Then Voted to Adjourn, this Meeting, to Thursday 10th December Next, — 1 Clock, in the Afternoon:— then to Meet, at the same place.
