Person to represent, the District of Middlesex, in  
the Congress, of the United States, ———

— And also, to give in their Votes, for Two  
Persons, as Candidates, for an Elector, of the  
President, and Vice President, of the United  
States. ——— Agreeable to late Resolutions  
of the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Legislature, of this Commonwealth.
