Then proceeded, to bring in their Votes, for Two
Persons, - as Candidates, for an Elector, of the
President, and Vice President, of the United States.

Wth
For Hon^{le} Oliver Prescott. ----- 30 Votes
For Hon^{le} Joseph B. Varnum. ----- 14 Votes
For John Brooks Esq^r. ----- 16 Votes
For Cap^t Asahel Wheeler. ----- 1 Vote
For Aaron Johnson. ----- 1 Vote.

Then, the Town, by Vote Dissolved this Meeting.

Monday 18th Decem^r - 1788

The Town being Met, agreeable to the fore-
going Adjournment, - Attended, to the Rev^d
Mr Biglow's Answer, as to his Acceptance or
Non Acceptance, of the 120 £, granted him, at a
former Meeting, as a Compensation, for the Depre-
ciation of his Galleries, in Paper Currency.

But, previous, to S^r Answer, - the Town Voted
to adjourn, to the House of Aaron Johnson.

The Town being Met, agreeable to the fore-
going Adjournment, - It was Voted that the
Moderator, be requested, to Ask, the Rev^d Mr
Biglow, for his Answer, as to the Town's Grant.

Which Answer, - for several Reasons, then
given, by the Rev^d Minister, - Was, a Rejection, of
the Grant, aforesaid.

221 Then the Town, reconsidered, their former Vote
of 120 £, granted, to make up Depreciation.

Then the Question was Asked, to see, if the Town
would supply the Rev^d Mr Biglow, with his Winter
Wood, by a Tax, & it pass'd in the Negative.
