Then the Town, Voted to choose a Committee, to inform the Selectmen, of East Sudbury, that the Rev. Mr. Biglow, hath made Application, to the Town of Sudbury, for the Depreciation of his Gallies, granted him in Paper Currency:— & further to Consult, the sd Selectmen, on the Subject.

And the Selectmen, were chosen, a Committee for the sd Purpose.

Then the Town, by Vote, Dissolv'd this Meeting.

— to give in their Votes, to the Selectmen for a Person, to Represent, the People, of the District of Middlesex, in the Congress, of the United States, — Agreeable, to a Precept, from his Excellency, the Governor, and Council of this Commonwealth.
