The Town, by Vote, Accepted the Warning of this Meeting.

Monday 16th February 1789.

The Town, being Mett, agreeable to the foregoing Warning proceeded, and chose, Capt. Asahel Wheeler, for their Moderator.

Then the Town, by Vote, Adjourned this Meeting to the House, of Aaron Johnson, Inholder in S. Town.

The Town, being Mett, agreeable to the foregoing Adjournment, proceeded, to the Business of the Meeting:— and Voted to pass over the first Article, for the present. — and proceed to the

2^d Article. — The Town, then called upon their Committee, as mentioned in this Article to make report, of their Doings. — Who reported, that after several Meetings, & Consultations, on the subject, they had, as yet, been unable to accomplish, the Business, to which, they were chosen.

Then the Town, took up the 1st Article, and Voted to choose a Committee of Two Persons, for the purpose expressed in this Article, — And Mr. Thomas Walter, and Capt. Asahel Wheeler were chosen: — to act, either in a Corporate or separate capacity, as circumstances, might render necessary: —

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Then the Town Voted, to add another person, to the S^d Committee, & Mr. James Thompson was added. — And also Voted, that the S^d Committee should consult, the Selectmen of East Windham, on the subject, And make report, to the Town, at the next March Meeting. —
The Town by Vote, Dissolved this Meeting.
