

March - Anno Domini 1789 -

There are to Notify & Warn all the Freeholders, & other Inhabitants, of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified as the Law Directs, to Vote, in Town Affairs, to meet at the Meeting House in Sudbury, on Monday the 2^d Day of March, Next, at 1 O'clock, in the Afternoon, on 2^d Day, ----- there and there,

1st To Choose a Moderator, Selectmen, Town Clerk, Town Treasurer, Overseers, Constables, and all other Town Officers, required by Law to be Annually chosen, in the month of March or April.

2^d To see, if the Town will Repair their Highways by a Rate, the present Year, and grant a suitable Sum of Money, for the Repairing of the same.

3^d To see, if the Town, will give Liberty, for Swine, to go at large, the present Year.

4th To see, if the Town will give Liberty for Horses to go at large without Fetters, any part of the present Year, from the 1st Day of April next, to the last Day of September next.

5th To see, if the Town, will give Liberty, for Sheep to go at large, from the 15th Day of March, to the 1st Day of May next.

6th To see, if the Town will Accept the Settlement of the Selectmen, with the Town Treasurer, and Order the same to be recorded.

7th The Article, relative to the Buying Yards, referred from October Meeting, to March Meeting.

8th To hear the Committee's Report, chosen in consequence of Warrant last against the Town; and also, to take such other Measures, on the Subject, as may be Agreeable to the Town when met.

9th To see, if the Town, will Call to Account, their Committee chosen, for the Purpose of Repairing or Rebuilding, the Common Bridge, - or do or act, any other Way, on this Article, as the Town may think proper, when met.

10th To see, if the Town, will, Agreeable to the Request, of Hope Brown & others, - Adopt some other Method, for the Collection of their Taxes, in future. Do or Act &c

11th To see, if the Town will, agreeable to the Request of Benjamin Smith, Allow him Six Shillings, - being for Necessarys, found Ephraim Goodnow, and Wife, in the Course, of the late War. - Do or Act &c

12th To see, if the Town will hear the Report, of their Committee chosen for the Purpose, of Examining into the Deficiency of the Town's Stock of Ammunition: - Or Do or Act &c

13th To see, if the Town, will Accept the Road, laid out by the Selectmen, on Hayne's Island, Do or Act &c
