3^d Pass'd in the Negative.

4th Article: Pass'd in the Negative.

5th Article, Pass'd in the Negative.

6th Article. - The Town Accepted the Settlement of the Selectmen, with the Town Treasurer, & ordered the same, to be recorded.

7th Article, Passed over, for the present.

Then the Question was put, to see if the Town would reconsider that part of the 2^d Article, relative to the Making the Highway Surveyor, Collector of S^d Rates, and it pass'd in the Negative.

8th Article. Then the Question was put, to see if the Town would take any Order, on this Article, and it pass'd in the Negative.

9th Article. The Town Allow'd the Content, as express'd in the 8^d Article.

10th Article. Then the Town Attended to the Report of the Committee refer'd to, in this Article, who reported that they had Discours'd Eno^m Richardson & Wife, on the subject, & that S^d Richardson & Wife, declared they were not conscious that any of the Town's Ammunition, Deposited at their House, had been clandestinely taken, by any Person.

Then Voted to choose a Committee to settle with Eno^m Richardson, as to Ammunition, & the Selectmen, were chosen, & empower'd to prosecute any Deficiency, in the S^d Stock, to final Judgment and Execution.

Then the Town, by Vote reconsidered their Doings relative to the 11th Article. - Then the Town, again took up, the 11th Article, And granted to M^r Benjamin Smith, as express'd in S^d Article.

227 Then the Town Voted to take up the 13th Article again, And finally Voted, to defer, the further consideration of it, to April Meeting. - Then it was Voted that the Selectmen, be request'd, to view the S^d Road, previous to, and make Report at, April Meeting.

228 Then the Town, by their Vote, Dissolved this Meeting.
