The Settlement of the Committee of Selectmen; with the Town Treasurer; for the Year 1787.

We the Subscribers; having settled accounts
with Moses Taft, Treasurer, for the Town, of
Sudbury; for the Year, 1787, — find the State
of the Treasury, for said Year, as follows.

Viz^t The whole of the Town Grants, for s^d Year,
amounts to the sum of 253 6 9

Of which Sum, Constable Thamar Price paid
to collect, and pay in, to the Treasurer, was 137 7 3

Of which Sum, he has, paid the Treasurer. 67 8 2

Remains Due the Town, in Constable Price's hands. 69 19 1

Of which Sum, Constable Asher Cutler's
part, to collect, & pay in to the Treasurer, was 115 19 7

Of which Sum, he has paid the Treasurer. 35 5 5 1/2

Remains Due the Town, in Constable Cutler's hands, 80 14 1 1/2

Remains Due the Town, in the Above two
Constables hands in the whole. 150 13 2 1/2
