

August Anno Domini 1789

These Are to Notify and Warn, all the Freeholders, & other Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified as the Law Directs, to Vote in Town Affairs, to meet at the Meeting House, in sd Town, on Monday the 17th Day, of this Instant August, - at 4 o'clock, Afternoon, on sd Day, - then & there,

To choose a Moderator, - and see, if the Town will also choose, some Person or Persons, to appear in Behalf of the Inhabitants of sd Town before Samuel P. Savage Esq<sup>r</sup> at his Dwelling House in Weston, on Tuesday the 23rd instant, 9 o'clock in the Forenoon, there to Answer, to Jonathan Hoar of East Sudbury, & Confessors make, (if they see cause) of the Demand stated against them: - As may more fully appear, by a Copy of sd Writ. - Do read &c.

This Notification, has been voted agreeable to the Town's Order. - W<sup>m</sup> Moses Taft Esq<sup>r</sup> Clerk.

The Town, by Vote Accepted the Warning of this Meeting.

Sudbury Monday the 17th August 1789.

The Town being Mett, agreeable to the foregoing Warning - Chose & chose Col<sup>l</sup> Jonathan Price, for their Moderator.

Then Voted to choose a Committee of Two Persons, for the purpose expressed, in this Article. And William Price Esq<sup>r</sup> - and Capt Isaac Wheeler were Chosen: - The Town, by their Vote, empowered the sd Committee, Not only to defend sd Action - agreeable to the Tenor, of the foregoing Article, but also, at any other Time & Place should there be a Necessity, for such Defence: - sd Committee to act in a Corporate or separate Capacity, as Circumstances may render Necessary.

The Town, then Voted, to Choose another Person, in Addition to sd Committee. And W<sup>m</sup> Isaac Maynard, was Added, & empowered as above.

231 Then the Town, by their Vote, Dissolved this Meeting.
