

October, Anno Domini 1789

These are to Notify & Warn, all the Freeholders, & other Inhabitants, of the Town of Dedbury, Qualified as the Law Directs, to Vote in Town Affairs: to Meet, at the Meeting House in said Town; on Monday the 26th Day of this Instant October; at 1 o'clock, ^{afternoon} on said Day, then, & there.

- 1st To Chose a Moderator, and bring in, Town Debt, and Credit.
- 2nd To see, if the Town, will Grant, to their Rev^d Minister, his Salary: for the Year ensuing: And make provision: for the Seasonable Collection of the same: Do or Act, any other Way, on this Article: As the Town, may think proper when Mett.
- 3rd To hear the Report, of the Committee, chosen at May Meeting: for the purpose, of enclosing the Burying Ground: And take such Measures, on this Subject; As the Town, may think proper when Mett.
- 4th To see, if the Town, will Make Provision for the Repairing, or the building the Meeting House in said Town, Or do or Act, any other Way; as the Town, may think proper, when Mett.
- 5th To see, if the Town, at the Request of M^r David Maynard, will Abate, his Rate in future, for a certain
- 6th To see, if the Town, will make provision, for the Town's Stock, of Ammunition, Do or Act de
- 7th To see, if the Town, will make provision, for Repairing, their Proposition, of the Long Causeway. Do or Act de
- 8th To see, if the Town, will Allow Interest, on the Remainder, of an Order, formerly given to Joseph Willym^s for 30 £, and now, in the hands of Warren Brigham. Do or Act de
- 9th To see, if the Town, will sell, or lett, the publick Securities, belonging to the Town; and now in the Treasury: Do or Act de
