- 10th To see, if the Town, will appropriate to the Use of a Reading & Writing School, the Remainder, of the Money; granted in October last: - for the Support of a Grammar School: - Do or Advise
- 11th To see, if the Town, will Grant Money, for the Support of a Grammar School, the ensuing Year, and Order, where the same shall be kept. - Do or Advise
- 12th To see, if the Town, will Grant Money, for the Support of a Reading & Writing School, the Year ensuing: And Order, where the same shall be kept. - Do or Advise
- 13th To see, if the Town, will Grant Money, for the Relief of the Poor, in the Town, the Year ensuing.
- 14th To see, if the Town, will Grant Money, to pay their Officers, and Treasurers, the present Year.
- 15th To see, if the Town, will Appoint a Man to take care of, and sweep, the Meeting House: - Ring the Bell, and Dig Graves, as Occasion may be, the Year ensuing.
