Then Voted, to choose a Committee of 7 Persons, for the purpose of looking out a place, suitable for a New Meeting House, - for Draughting, a plan, and for receiving proposals, from Individuals, relative to building the same; - And Ordered, said Committee, to report to the Town at March Meeting. The said Committee consisted of, Esq^r - Price, Col^l How, Capt^t Wheeler, M^r James Thompson, M^r Isaac Magnard, Col^l Price, & M^r Samuel Jones. - Also Voted, that the said Committee serve the Town, free of expence.

Allow'd to Deacon Samuel Lakin, for perambulating the Line, between Sudbury and Concord in April last. 3

Then the Town, Ordered the Treasurer, to discount Court^{ts} ble Ithamar Price Ephraim Goodenows that, on the principle of equity; - & deduct the same from an obligation, said Price, gave the Treas^r in behalf of said Town.

Then Discounted Court^{ts} ble Ithamar Price, Joseph Park's that, for 1782, 1786, & 1787

Allow'd, Capt Samuel Puffer, for Joseph Park's, rats 13 5
Do William Hayden, for Daniel Wait's that 16 8.

Then the Town, again took up, the 3^d article, and empowered their Committee, to purchase the Land, of M^r Doane, for the purpose of enlarging the Burying Ground; - And also Voted, that the Committee, proceed and build the Wall, round the Yard, on the best Terms, they can, for the benefit of the Town:

Then Voted to Adjourn this Meeting, to next Monday, 2^d of Clock, Afternoon, then to meet, at the same place.

The Town being Mett, agreeable to the foregoing Adjournment, proceeded and,

Allow'd to Aaron Johnson for repairing the Work^{rs} House, in the Year 1787 - finding Perish and an Iron Mantletree. 8 4
