The Town being Mett, agreeable to the foregoing Adjournment, Attended to the report of the Committee, Appointed for the purpose of determining, & Defining, the Limits of School Districts, within said Town; Who Reported that they had Determined upon 5 Districts, and exhibited Schedule, of each:— The Question was then put, to see, if the Town, would accept the Report of the Committee, as exhibited, and it pass'd in the Negative.

— The above Question, was again put, & again pass'd in the Negative.

— The Question, was then put, to see if the Town would Annex Samuel Cutting Samuel Gleason Ephraim Goodenow, Elijah Goodenow & Delucian Parminter, to the North-West District, and it pass'd in the Negative. c.

— The Question, was then put, to see, if the Town would have six Districts:— in 2^d Town, & it pass'd in the Negative:— The Question was then asked, for seven Districts, & it pass'd in the Negative.

— The Question, was then asked, to see, if the Town would accept the Report, of the Committee, as by them exhibited, and it pass'd in the Affirmative.

— Then the Town by their Vote, ordered the Schedule of the five Districts, as exhibited by the Committee, to be recorded.

Then Voted to Dissolve this Meeting
