

March Anno Domini 1790

These are to Notify & Warn, all the Freeholders, & other Inhabitants, of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified as the Law directs, to Vote in Town Affairs, to Meet, at the Meeting House, in sd Town, on Monday the 1st Day of March next, 1 O'clock in the Afternoon, on 2^d Day, ——— then & there. —

Article 1st To choose a Moderator, Town Clerk, Selectmen, Town Treasurer, a Justice, Constable, and all other Town Officers, required by Law, to be Annually chosen, in the Month of March, or April.

2^d To See, if the Town, will Repair their Highways, by a Rate, the present Year, and Grant a suitable Sum of Money, for the Repairing of the same.

3^d To See, if the Town, will give Liberty for Service to go at Large, the present Year.

4th To See, if the Town, will give Liberty for Morrie to go at Large, without Letters, any part of the present Year, from the 1st Day of April next, to the last Day of September next.

5th To See, if the Town, will give Liberty, for Sheep, to go at Large, from the 1st Day of March, to the 1st Day of May next.

6th To See, if the Town, will Accept the Settlement, of the Selectmen, with the Town Treasurer, & Order the same to be recorded.

7th To See, if the Town, will empower their Treasurer, to Quitclaim to the Trustees, of the Donation for East-Sudbury, a certain piece of Land, formerly the property of Daniel Wyman, late of East-Sudbury Decas'd: — DO or AWT, as the Town may think proper when Met.
