

With Arms Domini 1790.

5th Article // Passed in the Negative.

6th Article // Passed over, for the present.

7th Article // Voted, that the Treasurer, be empowered to Quit-claims, &c as set forth in the said Article.

8th Article // Voted, to call upon the Committee, refer'd to in this Article, - for Report. - Then Voted, that this Article, be put over to April Meeting: - that the Committee may have Opportunity, for completing the Sale, of S^d Land.

9th Article // Voted, to Dismiss, this Article.

10th Article // Voted, to choose a Committee, for the purpose of enquiring, into the propriety of Mr Conant's request, and report, to the Town, at April Meeting. - The Committee chosen, were, Moses Tappan - Mr Isaac Maynard, and Mr John Maynard. - Then Voted, to reconsider, the Vote, relative to the Committee refer'd to, in this Tenth Article.

Then the Town, proceeded, to the Choice of a County Treas^r. Viz^t: For the Hon^{ble} Eleazer Bridge Esq^r 28 Votes.

Then Voted, to Adjourn, this Meeting, to Monday Next, at 3 Clock, afternoon. - then to meet, at this place.

Monday Morning 8th March 1790.

The Town being Met, agreeable to the foregoing Adjournment, - Attended to Mr Elisha Goodenow's Excuse, for not accepting the Office of Constable, which Excuse, was rejected, by the Town. - Then the s^d Elisha Goodenow, in Open Town Meeting, declared his Reg^d Acceptance, of the s^d Office.

Then Voted, to proceed to the Choice, of a Constable for the South Ward; And Mr Daniel Woodward Moore, was chosen, to the s^d Office.
