Article 1st // To bring in their Votes, for a Governor, Lt
Governor, and Senators, for the Year ensuing: —

2^d To choose, a Moderator, — and see, if the Town, will
sell off, Benj^a Smith and Others, Petitioners, with
their Lands, & Buildings, from the Town of Sudbury, that
they may be Annex'd to the Town of Stow: — DO OR ACT
on this Article, As the Town may think proper, when Met.

3^d To see, if the Town, will Grant to Jonathan Smith,
the Privilege, of serving as a Collector, instead of Constable,
the Year ensuing: — And choose some Person, to the Office of
Constable, DO OR ACT &

4th To see, if the Town, will Accept, the Settlement, of the
Selectmen, with the Town Treasurer, and Order, the same
to be Recorded. DO OR ACT &

To see, if the Town, will Dismiss their Old Committee,
and choose, a New Committee, for the purpose of Com
promising, the Contest, between the Town, Col^d Wood,
and Esq^r Richardson: — As to the 30 Rod, Highway,
agreeable to the Petition, of Levi Holdin, & Others,
