

April Anno Domini 1790.

At a Legal Town Meeting, held in Sudbury,
on Monday the 3rd Day of April 1790. The Town, pro-
ceeded, to bring in their Votes, for a Governor; - - -

Viz^t For his Excellency John Hancock Esquire 59 Votes.

For Hon^{ble} James Bowdoin Esq^r - - - - - 3 Votes.

For Hon^{ble} Oliver Prescott Esq^r - - - - - 1 Vote.

Then proceeded, to bring in their Votes, for a Lieut^t Governor.

Viz^t For his Honor, Samuel Adams, Esquire - 42 Votes.

For Cap^t Asahel Wheeler. - - - - - 1 Vote.

Then proceeded, to bring in their Votes, for 5 Senators.

Viz^t For Hon^{ble} Joseph B. Varnum, Esq^r - - - - - 38 Votes.

For Hon^{ble} Ebenezer Bridge Esq^r - - - - - 40 Votes.

For Hon^{ble} Nathaniel Gorham Esq^r - - - - - 29 Votes.

For Joseph Curtiss Esq^r - - - - - 28 Votes.

For William Price Esq^r - - - - - 27 Votes.

For Hon^{ble} Joseph Horner. - - - - - 22 Votes.

For John Brooks Esq^r - - - - - 9 Votes.

For Hon^{ble} Eleazar Brooks. - - - - - 5 Votes.

For Hon^{ble} James Prescott. - - - - - 6 Votes.

For Doctor Marshall Spring. - - - - - 4 Votes.

For Cap^t Asahel Wheeler. - - - - - 2 Votes.

For Hon^{ble} Isaac Stearns. - - - - - 1 Vote.

For William Hull Esq^r - - - - - 1 Vote.

For M^r Joseph How. - - - - - 1 Vote.

For Elisha Doane. - - - - - 1 Vote.

For Aaron Johnson. - - - - - 1 Vote.

Then proceeded, to the 2^d Article, of those Col^d Priv^s
for their Moderator. - Then attended, to the Petition,
compris'd in this Article: - Which Request, as contain'd
in this 3^d Article: - Unanimously passed in the Negative. -

3^d Article // Then Voted to excuse M^r Jonathan Smith,
from serving as Constable, the present year; in case,
he shall serve the Town, as a Collector; - then pro-
ceeded, & chose M^r Jonathan Smith, as a collector of
Taxes, for the North Ward, the ensuing year.
