

April Anno Domini 1790.

Then The Town Clerk, Administred to the said Jonathan Smith, (in open Town Meeting) the Oath, Annexed to the Office of Collector.

Then the Town, chose Deaⁿ Thomas Walker, Constable, for said Town, the Year ensuing.

4th Article // The Town, by Vote, Accepted the Settlement, of the Selectmen, with the Town Treasurer, in its present Form: - and Ordered the same to be Recorded.

Then the Town, pass'd a Resolue, that the Selectmen, take up, several Orders, (the Property of the Treasurer) bearing Date, prior to the last, & some former Settlements, and grant a New Order, in lieu thereof.

5th Article. // Voted, that no Order, be taken on this Article.

6th Granted, the Request, as contain'd in this Article.

7th Passed over, for the present.

8th The Committee, refer'd to, in this Article, reported, as follows, Viz^t: That they had Draughted a Plan (which was presented) and that the Majority had Determined, that the New House, be erected, as nigh the Old one, As the Situations of the Ground, will conveniently admit.

9th Article, Passed over, for the present.

Then Voted, to Adjourn, this Meeting, to Monday Next, 4 Clock, Afternoon, then to Meet, at the same place.

Sudbury Monday 12th April 1790

The Town being Mett, agreeable, to the foregoing Adjournment, Voted to take up, the 7th Article, and after some Debate, - proceeded to a consideration of the

10th Article // And Voted, to choose Town, Fish Wardens, the Year ensuing.
