

May Anno Domini 1790.

At a Legal Town Meeting, held in Sudbury, on Monday the 10th Day of May 1790. The Town, proceeded, to the Business of 2^d Day: And Voted, to send a Representation, to General Court, the year ensuing.

The Question, was then asked, to see, if the Town, would establish the pay, of the Representation, the year ensuing: and it pass'd in the Negative.

Article 1st // Then, the Town, by Vote, made choice of William Price Esq^r a Freeholder, & Resident, in 2^d Town, to serve for, and Represent 2^d Town, in General Court, the year ensuing.

Then proceeded to the second Article, and chose Capt. Asahel Wheeler, for their Moderator.

2^d The Town, by Vote, empowered the Treasurer, to Receipt with Capt^t Augustus Moore, for the Assessments, or any part, of the 2^d Assessments, which appear, to remain uncollected, which shall be receiv'd of the Treasurer, as so much ready Money: - And also, for the Receipt & other evidences, of Payment, by him receiv'd, agreeable to the Direction, of his Warrants.

= Then the Town, Ordered the Treasurer, to receive a Note of Hand, sign'd by Levi Holden for 25 £. and Receipt Capt^t Augustus Moore, for the same, as so much Cash.

= Then Voted to hire some person, for completing the Collections, on the Assessments, committed to Capt^t Augustus Moore.

= Then Voted, to choose a person, for the purpose of Adopting such Measures, for liberating Capt^t Moore, from Goal: - As may be consistent, with the Town's Interest: & Deaⁿ Thomas Walker, was accordingly chosen.

= Then the Town, reconsidered their Vote, for hiring a person, to complete the Collections, on Capt^t Moore's Assessments.

= Then Voted, to choose a Collector, for completing the Collections, on the Assessments, formerly committed to Capt^t Augustus Moore, - - - And
