These are to Notify, and Warn, all the Freeholders, and other Inhabitants, of the Town of Sudbury, duly Qualified to Vote, for Representatives, to the General Court, of this Commonwealth, And those Qualified, as the Law Direct, to Vote in Town Affairs: - to Meet, at the Meeting House, in s^d Town, on Monday, the 4th Day of October next, at 1 Clock, Afternoon on s^d Day, then & there,

1st - To give in their Votes, to the Selectmen, for a Person, to Represent, the People, in the District of Middlesex, in the Congress, of the United States: - Agreeable to a Resolution, of the Honourable Legislature, of this Commonwealth.

2^d - To choose a Moderator, and bring in Town-Debts, and Credit.

3^d - To See, if the Town will take Measures, for enclosing the Burying Yard, in a Decent Manner. &c or Act. &c

4th - To See if the Town, will take Measures, for removing the School House, in the North-east part of the Town, to such Place, as the Town shall agree upon, or Repair, or Rebuild, or do or act, relative to s^d House, as shall be most agreeable to the Town, when Met.
