

October, Anno Domini 1790

5th — To See, if the Town will take Measures, for raising their part, of the Causeways, commonly called the Long and Short Causeways. Do or Act &c.

6th — To See, if the Town, will Accept the List, of Jurors, as presented by the Selectmen.

7th — To See, if the Town, will Accept Deacon Thomas Walner, as a Constable, for the South Ward, the present year, in the stead of Mr Elisha Goodenow.

8th — To See, if the Town, will Agree, to sell, or exchange, part of the Ministerial Lands, for such other Property, as shall to them appear, most for the Interest, of the Parties concerned: — Agreeable to the petition of Moses Mosman, & others. Do or Act &c.
