4th = Voted to choose a Committee of Three persons, for the purpose of Viewing the School House in the North-east part of the Town, And M^r John Maynard, Capt. Holdin, and M^r Samuel Jones, were chosen: = Then Ordered, the said Committee, to report, at the Adjournment, of this Meeting, the propriety or impropriety, of rebuilding or removing the S^d House.

5th = Taped over, to the Adjournment of this Meeting.

6th = The Town, Accepted the List of Jurors, as presented by the Selectmen.

7th = The Town Accepted Deacon Thomas Walker, as a Constable for the South Ward, the present year, in the stead of M^r Elisha Goodenow.
