

October Anno Domini 1790

Resolved to Notify and Warn, all the Freeholders and other Inhabitants, of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified as the Law Directs, to Vote in Town Affairs, to meet at the Meeting House, in sd Town, on Monday the 8th Day of November next, at 2 O'clock, Afternoon, on sd Day, then and there.

1st — To choose a Moderator, bring in Town Debt, and Credit, and See, if the Town will grant, to their Pres^t. Minister, his Salary, for the Year ensuing: — Or Do, or Act, any other Way, on this Article, as the Town may think proper when Met.

2^d — To See, if the Town, will grant, or appropriate a Sum of Money, necessary for the Support of a Grammar School, in sd Town, the ensuing year, and order where the same shall be kept.

3^d — To See, if the Town, will grant Money, for the Support of a Reading and Writing School, the ensuing year, and order where the same, shall be kept.

4th — To See, if the Town, will grant Money, for the Relief of the Poor, in sd Town, the Year ensuing.

5th — To See, if the Town, will grant Money, to pay their Assessors, and Treasurer, the present Year.

6th — To See, if the Town, will Appoint a Man, to take care of, and sweep the Meeting House, ring the Bell, and Dig Graves, as Occasion may be, the Year ensuing.

7th — To See, if the Town, will grant, or appropriate a Sum of Money, necessary for the Purchase, of a Town Stock of Ammunition.

8th — To See, if the Town will, agreeable to the Request, of Capt^t Goodenow, sell the Warehouse, in sd Town, or Do or Act, thereon, as the Town, may think proper, when Met.

9th — To See, if the Town, will choose an Agent or Agents, to appear in Behalf of sd Town, at the Court of Common Pleas, next to be holden, at Cambridge, in & for,
