

March Anno Domini 1791

There are to Notify and Warn, all the Free-
holders, and other Inhabitants, of the Town of Sud-
bury, Qualified, as the Law directs, to Vote in Town
Affairs; to meet at the Meeting House, in S^d Town,
on Monday the 7th Day, of March next, at 1 O'Clock
afternoon, on S^d Day: — then and there. —

Article 1st To choose a Moderator, Town-Clerk,
Selectmen, Town Treasurer, Assessors, Constables,
and all other Town Officers, required by Law, to
be Annually chosen, in the Months, of March,
or April.

2^d — To See, if the Town, will repair their
Highways, by a Rate, the present Year, and Grant
a suitable Sum, of Money, for repairing the same.

3^d — To See, if the Town, will give Liberty for
Horses, to go at large, the present Year.

4th — To See, if the Town, will give Liberty, for
Horses, to go at large, without Tethers, any part
of the present Year, from the first Day of April,
to the last Day, of September next.

5th — To See, if the Town, will give Liberty for
Horses, to go at large, from the 15th Day of March,
to the 1st Day of May next.

6th — To See, if the Town, will accept, the Settle-
ment, of the Selectmen, with the Town Treas-
urer, and Order, the same to be recorded.

7th — To See, if the Town, will choose, a Man, or
Men, in addition to their Committee, for selling
Lancaster Rd Road, or 30 Rod highway: and
further to Attend, to other Matters, relative to S^d Road
as contained, in a Petition, sign'd by Peter
Haynes, and others: reference being had, to said
Petition. Do or alt. &c
