- 2^d To choose a Moderator: And act upon the 6th 8th 11th 12th & 13th Articles in the Warning of March Meeting: which were put over, to April Meeting, for further consideration.
- 3 To fill up the Vacancy, in those Town Offices which the Law requires: should any Office appear to be Vacant.
- 4th To see, if the Town, will attend to the report of their Committee, chosen, to confer, with East-Sudbury on the propriety of a Lottery: for repairing the long & short Caluways, in S. Towne. Do or act &c
- 5th To see if the Town, will give their Committee, any further Instructions, relative to enclosing the Land at the East end of the Burying Yard: Do or act &c
- 6th To see, if the Town, will give liberty, or consent, that the person chosen, as Constable the present year, should serve, as Collector of Taxes only, Do or act &c
- 7th To see, if the Town, will take Measures, for collecting the Ballance, due S. Town, from Constable Thomas Price — Do or act &c
