There are to Notify, & Warn, all the Freeholders, & other Inhabitants, of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified, according to the Constitution, of this Commonwealth, to vote in the choice of a Representative; And those Qualified as the Law directs, to vote in Town Affairs, to Meet at the Meeting House, in s^d Town, on Mon-
-day, the 9th Day of May next, at 1 Clock, afternoon on s^d Day: - then & there.

1st To elect or depute, some suitable Person, ~~after~~
~~being~~ being a Freeholder, & resident in s^d Town, to serve for & represent s^d Town, in a great, and General Court, Appointed to be conven'd, held, & kept, for the service of this Commonwealth, at the State House, in Boston, on Wednesday the 25th Day of May next: - agreeable to a Law, of this Commonwealth, in that case, made & provided.

2^d To choose a Moderator, and act upon, the 13th Article, in the Warning of March Meeting, & the 7th in the Warning of April Meeting: - just over, to May Meeting, for further Consideration.

3^d To See, if the Town, at the Request, of Moses Taft, will take into Consideration, some publick Securities, (the property of s^d Town,) by him dispos'd off: - the Consent of Town, not being first, had & Obtain'd: - Do or act as

4th To See, if the Town, will Build a New; - or re-
-move the Old School House, in the East District, in s^d Town. - Do or act as

To See, if the Town will Grant, to the Singing
s^d Society, in s^d Town, (during the Town's pleasure)
5th So much of the Front Gallery, in the Meeting House, as may be Necessary, for the Accomo-
-dation of s^d Society: - Agreeable to the petition of Aaron Haynes, & others. Do or act as
