- = Center of S^d Town; & it pass'd in the Negative.
- = The Question, was then asked, to see, if the Town would erect the New House, as nigh, the old one as the situation, of the Ground, would conveniently admit, & it pass'd, in the Affirmative.
- = Then reconsidered, the Vote, immediately preceding; & And Voted, to chuse a Committee, for Draughting, a Plan, of a New Meeting House, & look out, a convenient spot, for erecting the same; & further, to receive, such other Instructions, as the Town, may give: & report, at next October Meeting. & it pass'd in the Affirmative.
- = The Question, was then asked, to see, whether the Town, would reconsider, all their former proceedings at this Meeting, relative to the Meeting House; & it pass'd in the Negative.
- = Then Voted, to chuse, a Committee of two persons, from each School District; & one at large: As a Committee, for Draughting, a Plan, agreeable to a former Vote; & then Voted, that the one at large, be chosen by ballot: Committee chosen, - was as follows: - For the Center District, M^r John Brigham, & Esq^r Price: - For the North East: - M^r Isaac Maynard, & M^r Samuel Jones: - For the North West: - Col^l Price, & Capt^t Bowker: - For the South West, Col^l How, & Deacon Walker, For the South East, Capt^t Holdin, & Capt^t Goodenow.
- = Then Voted, to excuse Col^l How, from serving on the aforesaid Committee, & chose Capt^t Israel Moore, in his stead.
- = Then Reconsidered, the Vote, for choosing, one at large: & Voted, that the Ten, already chosen, be Authorised, to transact the Business, as above express'd.
- = Then Voted, to Direct the Treasurer, to Issue his Warrant, against Constable Thamar Price unless, he produce a Receipt, from M^r Biglow, in full, for his Gallery, now in Price's Hands.
