These, are to Notify, & Warn, all the Freeholders, & other Inhabitants, of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified, as the Law directs, to Vote in Town Affairs, to Meet, at the Meeting House, in s^d Town, on Monday, the 17th Day, of this instant October, at 1 o'clock after-noon, on s^d Day, then & there

- 1st To choose a Moderator, bring in Town Debt, & Credit, and See if the Town will Grant, to their Rev^d Minister, his Salary, for the Year ensuing, & Do or Act, any other Way, on this Article, as the Town may think proper when Met.
- 2nd To See if the Town, will Attend, to the Report, of their Committee, relative to the Meeting House.
- 3rd To See, if the Town, will Grant Money, for the support, of a Grammar School, in s^d Town, the Year ensuing: & order, where the same shall be kept.
- 4th To See, if the Town, will Grant Money, for support, of a Reading & Writing School, the Year ensuing, & Order, where the same shall be kept.
- 5th To See, if the Town, will Grant Money, for the Relief of the Poor, in s^d Town, the Year ensuing.
- 6th To See, if the Town, will Grant Money, to pay their Treasurer, & Expenses, the present Year.
- 7th To See, if the Town, will Appoint a Man to take care of, & Sweep the Meeting House, ring the Bell, & Dig Graves, as occasion may be, the Year ensuing.
- 8th To See, if the Town, will choose a Committee, for ascertaining the Bounds, round the Training Fields, in s^d Town, Do or Act &c
