These are to Notify, and Warn all the Freeholders, and Other Inhabitants, of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified, as the Law directs, to Vote, in Town Affairs, to Meet at the Meeting House, in said Town, on Monday, the 21st Day of November next, at 1 O'clock, afternoon, on said Day, then and there.

1st To choose a Moderator.

2^d To take into further Consideration, the subject matter, relative to the building a new Meeting House, in said Town, - with the Plan of the same. - and appointing a place, where the said House shall be erected. - And grant Money, for building the same. - Or Do, or Act, on any other Matter, or thing, relating to said House, as the Town, may think proper, when Met.
