

November Anno Domini 1791

Sunday Monday 21st November, 1791. At a
Legal Meeting, in sd Town, on the Day & Year above
proceed to the Business of said Meeting: & chose
Capt Jon^a Price, Moderator, then proceeded to the 2^d
Article and Voted, to build, a new meeting House, in
said Town, — 63 for building, & 37 against. —
The Question was then asked, to see if the Town, would
have the new House, erected, as near the center of the
Travel of the whole Inhabitants of sd Town, as
may be convenient, for erecting sd House, & it
pass'd in the Negative. — The Question was
then asked, to see, whether the Town, would have the
new House, erected upon the Identical Spot, on
which the present House, now stands, and it pass'd
in the Affirmative, — then the Town, reconsidered
the Vote, last past. — Then Voted, to choose a Com-
mittee of Five persons, for the purpose of Staking
out, a spot of Ground, whereon to erect a new Meeting
House. said Spot of Ground, to be staked out, as nigh
the situation of the present House, as the Land will
conveniently admit. — Committee chosen were Capt
Levi Holden, Mr Isaac Maynard, Esq^r Price, Mr John
Maynard, & Mr Phineas Tuffer. — Then Voted that
said Committee, immediately proceed to sd business,
& report to the Town forthwith. — Then Voted to ad-
journ, this Meeting, for the space of one Quarter of an
Hour, then to meet at the same place.

The Town being met, agreeable to the foregoing
Adjournment, proceeded and called for the Report
of their Committee, who reported, & the Report, was
by Vote rejected. — Then Voted, that the North Side of
the new Meeting House, should cover the Ground, that
the present side, now covers, & that the Addition, or en-
largement of the new House, be made South & west.
Then Voted, that the plan, of a Meeting House, as
presented by Capt Bowker, be committed to the Committee
who reported the former plan, for their perusal, and
report at this Meeting.
