

January Anno Domini 1792

The Town being Mett, agreeable to the foregoing adjournment, called upon the Committee for report, chosen for draughting a plan, of a Meeting House, who reported, & presented a plan: - then Voted to inspect a plan, of a Meeting House, as presented, by Mr Biglow. - then the Question was asked to see whether the Town, would accept the proposal, made by St. Joseph How, for repairing the old Meeting House, & it pass'd in the Negative. - The Question, was then asked, to see whether the Town, would appoint a Committee, to take into Consideration the two plans, exhibited by the Town, this Day, and report to the Town which of the two, in their Opinion, is the most eligible, said Committee, to consist of five Viz^t Capt^t Levi Holden, Mr James Thompson, Capt^t Jonas Holden, Col^l How, & Capt^t Goodenow. - Then Voted, to excuse, the Committee last chosen, from said service, - & then chose the following Viz^t Mr James Thompson, Capt^t Levi Holden, Capt^t Wheeler, Mr Isaac Maynard, & Col^l Prier; - then the Question was asked, to see whether, the Town, would accept the plan as exhibited, by their Committee, appointed for said purpose, & it pass'd in the Negative.

The Question, was then asked, to see whether the Town, would accept, the plan, as exhibited by the Committee, with leaving out the front porch, and it pass'd in the Affirmative.

Then Voted, to adjourn this Meeting, for one fortnight, 10 Clock afternoon, to meet at this place.
