

March Anno Domini 1792

- 3rd To See, if the Town will give Liberty for Swine to go at Large, the present Year.
- 4th To See, if the Town, will give Liberty for Horses, to go at Large, without Trotters, any part of the present Year, from the 1st Day of April, to the last Day of September next.
- 5th To See, if the Town, will give Liberty for Sheep, to go at Large, from the 15th Day of March, to the first Day of May next.
- 6th To See, if the Town, will accept the Settlement of the Selectmen with the Town Treasurer, & Order the same to be recorded.
- 7th To See, if the Town, will take Measures for renting out, the new ground, in the Meeting House, in this Town, agreeable to the petition of Joshua Haynes & others, Do or not do
- 8th To See, if the Town, will attend to the Report of their Committee, chosen for the purpose of ascertaining the bounds, round the Training Field, in this Town, Do or not do
- 9th To See, if the Town, will Allow, to Ephraim Barker, the Average, allow'd by the Town, to certain Soldiers, doing Duty, in the Continental Army, in the Year 1776. - agreeable to the Request, of S^r Barker, Do or not do
- 10th To See, if the Town, will establish the Road, by Cap^t Jonathan Bents House, where it is now trod, so far, as he owns the Land, on each side of said Road, & allow him, the Land, formerly laid out, as a Road, adjoining the Meadow, in lieu thereof. - Do or not do
- 11th To See, if the Town, will give their Committee, any further Instructions, relative to the Dispute between the Town, & the Town of Northborough, and another provision, for the capture, of further
