

April Anno Domini 1792

These are to Notify, and Warn, all the Male Inhabitants, of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified, as is provided, in the Constitution, of this Commonwealth, to Vote, in the Choice, of a Governor, Lt. Governor, and Senators, for the Year ensuing and all others, Qualified as the Law directs, To Vote in Town Affairs, to meet at the Meeting House in said Town, on Monday, the 2^d Day of April next, at 1 O'clock, Afternoon, on 3^d Day, then & there,

= 1st To bring in their Votes, for a Governor Lt. Governor, & Senators, for the Year ensuing.

= 2nd To choose a Moderator and Act upon the 6th of the 8th 9th and 11th articles, in the warning of March Meeting, put over to April Meeting for further consideration.

= 3rd To fill up, the Vacancy, in those Town Offices, which the Law requires, should any office, appear to be vacant.

= 4th To See, if the Town will attend to the Memorial of the Representatives, of sundry Towns, in the County of Middlesex, for establishing the Town of Concord, as the Shire Town, of sd County, with the Order of Court, thereon: Do or Act, as the Town may think proper, when Met.

= 5th To See, if the Town, will sell to M^r Ephraim Carter, of East Sudbury, the Training Field, situate in the South easterly part of sd Town of Sudbury: Do or Act &c

= 6th To See, if the Town, will Order the powder, with a Number of Cartridges, lying ^{former} a part of the Town's Stock, of Ammunition, to be sold. Do or Act &c
