- = 1st Article as contained in this 2^d Article. -
Voted that the further prosecution, as contain'd
in this Article. - be left discretionary, with the
Committee, on a Motion.
- = 3^d Article, Voted to proceed, to the choice, of a
Constable for the North ward, and ^{Samuel, by the electors, of S^d Town} Mr. Phineas
Puffer, was chosen, to S^d Office. - Mr. Daniel
Woodward Moore, appeared, before the Town, and
consented, to serve as Constable. - Then caused
Edward Boynton, from serving as Hog reeve,
the present year, and chose Hezekiah Johnson,
in his stead. - Then Voted, to cause Mr.
Isaac Maynard, from serving, as a Surveyor
of Horses, the present year, and chose ^{Mr} Jacob
Pread, in his stead. - Then proceeded to the
choice of a Fish-warden, in the stead, of Mr. Abel
Willis, and Mr. Uriah Gibbs, was chosen.
- = 4th Article, was refer'd to may Meeting, for
further consideration.
- = 5th Article, Voted to sell, the Training Field,
in the South Easterly part, of said Town. - And
then Voted, that the Committee formerly ap-
-pointed, for the sale of the Workhouse, be au-
-thorised to sell, the aforesaid Training Field,
to the best advantage of S^d Town.
- = 6th Article, was by Vote, passed over.
- = 7th Article, refer'd to October Meeting.
- Then Voted to Dissolve this Meeting.
