

May, Anno Domini 1792 -

- These are to Notify, & Warn, all the Freeholders, & Other Inhabitants, of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified, agreeable to the Constitution, of this Commonwealth, to vote in the choice of a Representative, - And all others, Qualified as the Law Directs, to Vote in Town Affairs, to Meet at the Meeting House, in sd Town, on Monday, the 7th Day of May next, at 1 O'clock afternoon, on said Day, then & there.
- 1st To elect, or depute, some suitable person, being a Freeholder, and Resident, in sd Town, to serve for, & represent, sd Town, in a Great & General Court, Appointed to be convened, - held, & kept, for the service of this Commonwealth, at the State House, in Boston, on Wednesday, the 30th Day of May next, Agreeable, to a Law, of the Commonwealth, in that Case, made and provided.
- 2nd To choose, a Moderator, and act upon the fourth Article, in the Warning of April Meeting, refer'd to May Meeting, for further consideration.
- 3rd To see, if the Town, will Order, their Treasurer, to pass a Deed, of the Training Field, on the south easterly part, of the Town, & take security for the Money, agreeable to the Conditions of Sale, Or Deed, or Act, as the Town, may think proper, when Met.
- 4th To see if the Town, will appropriate a part, of the Money, arising from the Sale, of the Work House (so called) towards the expenses of defending the process, brought, against the Town, by the Town of Northborough.
