previous to the 1st of June, otherwise the Town
not to be held, to 1st Sale; as above refer'd to. —

= 4th Article — Appropriated £5..5.. — out of
= the Money, as Mentioned, in this Article, and
for the purpose, within Mentioned. —

= 5th Article, Passed over, by Vote of Town. —

= 6th Article Accepted Cap^t Samuel Knight,
= as a Constable for the South Ward, the present
year, in stead of Mr Daniel W^d Moore. — Said
Knight, has taken the Oath of Office, before the Clerk
of said Town. —
