2^d To take the Voice of the Town, relative
to Appointing, a House, or Houses; - for the
Reception, of those, - who may be disposed, to take
the Infection, of the Small-Pox, by Inoculation.
DO or D^N, any Way, on the Subject, as the Town
may think proper, when Mett^d - agreeable to the
Petition, of Benjamin Maynard, & others.
