These are to Notify, and Warn, all the Freeholders, and other Inhabitants, of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified to Vote in Town Affairs, to Meet, at the Meeting House in sd Town, on Monday, the 12th Day of November inst., at 4 O'clock, afternoon, then and there.

1st To choose a Moderator. —

2nd To See if the Town, will make any further provision, for carrying on the Law Suit, — between the Towns of Sudbury & Northborough now pending, in the Supreme Judicial Court,

3rd To See, if the Town will ^{DO or not} grant a sum of Money for the purpose of paying the Demand, made by John Richardson against the Town of Sudbury, — for supporting Ebenezer Burbank, while confin'd in Goal, for Taxes. —

4th To See if the Town, will choose some suitable Person, — for Town-keeper, in sd Town. —

5th To See if the Town, will make provision, for paying the Prev^d M^r Bigelow, the Depreciation, upon his Sallerys. —
