

November Anno Domini 1792

This Notification was Tosted, agreeable to
a former Vote, of Town, & Accepted by Vote.
Sudbury Monday, 12th November 1792

— At a Legal Town Meeting, held in
Sudbury, on the Day and Year abovesaid, pro-
ceeded to the Business of 1st Day, and chose Col^l
Jonathan Price, Moderator. — then Voted to choose
a Town Clerk, pro tempore, & Capt Joseph
Goodenow, was chosen.

4th Then the Town, took up, the 4th Article, and
made choice of Aaron Johnson, as a Pound
Keeper.

5th Voted to choose a Committee of Three per-
sons, to wait upon the Rev^d Mr. Priglow, and
report at the adjournment of this Meeting;
and Col^l Price, Capt Goodenow, & Capt
Levi Holden, were chosen.

— Then the Town, by their Vote adjourned
this Meeting, to the first Monday in Decem^r
next, at 2 O'Clock, Afternoon, at this place.
Monday December 3rd 1792

— The Town, being Met agreeable to the for-
going adjournment, the Meeting being opened,
proceeded, to the 2^d Article.

2^d The Question was asked, to see, if the Town
would Grant Money, for the further prosecution
of the Action, Mentioned in this Article, and it passed
in the Negative.

— Then the Question, was asked, to see, if
the Town, would Grant Twenty Pounds, for
the purpose, of paying a Bill of Cost, which has
and may arise, in consequence of the Action
Mentioned, in this Article, the Committee to be
accountable, for the same.

Granted Twenty Pounds, for the purpose
expressed, in this Article, and Ordered, their
