Monday January 14th 1793

At a legal Town Meeting, held in Sud-
bury, the Day, and Year abovesaid. - proceeded, and ac-
- cepted, the warning, of this Meeting: - And brought
in their Votes for Federal Representation, as follows.
Viz^t For Hon^{ble} Samuel Holten Esq^r - 28 Votes.

2^d Article. - Chose Col^l John^a Phin - Moderator.

3^d Article. - After a long Debate, upon the Subject,
- matter, contain'd in, this Article: - the Question was,
asked, if the Town, would direct the Selectmen, to take
all prudent Measures, - to lessen the Number of
Houses, infected with the Small Pox; - and also to pre-
- vent, the further Spreading, of the Disorder; - And it pass'd
in the Affirmative.

Then the Question, was asked, if the Town
would Appoint the Selectmen a Committee, for
the purpose of prosecuting, any person, or persons, that
have, or may transgress the Law, respecting, the Small
-pox; - And it pass'd, in the Affirmative.

Then Voted, to adjourn this Meeting to Mr.
Nathan Johnson's.
