Then Voted to adjourn, this Meeting, to Monday next, 1 O'clock afternoon, at the Meeting House.

Monday 21st January 1793

The Town, being met agreeable to the foregoing adjournment, proceeded, to the further consideration, of the 3rd Article: - And after, having had the subject, under Consideration, for some time: Voted to dissolve this Meeting.

- These are to Notify and warn all the Freeholders and other Inhabitants, of the town of Sudbury, Qualified as the Law directs, to vote in town affairs, to Meet at the Meeting House in sd town, on Monday the 4th day of March next at 1. O'clock afternoon on sd day - the ward there
- 1st To Choose a Moderator, town Clerk, Selectmen, Town Treasurer, Assessors Constables, and all other town officers, Required by Law, to be Annually Chosen, in the Months of March or April.
 - 2^d To See if the town, will repair their Highways by a Rate the present year, and Grant a Suitable Sum of Money, for repairing the same.
 - 3^d To See if the Town, will Give Liberty for Swine to Go at Large, the present year.
