

March Anno Domini 1793

- 4th To See, if the Town will Give Liberty, for Horses, to go at Large, without Letters, any part of the present year, from the first day of April, to the Last day of September, Next
- 5th To See, if the Town, will Give Liberty, for Sheep, to go at Large, From the 15th day of March, to the 1st day of May Next, —
- 6th To See, if the Town, will Accept the Settlement, of the Selectmen, with the Town Treasurer, and order the Same to be Recorded —
- 7th To See, if the Town, will make provision, for fencing the Ministerial Lot, in the Centre of sd town, in whole or In part, Agreeable to the Request, of Lt Bogle, Do or act, &c
- 8th To See, if the Town, agreeable to the petition of Henry Smith, and others, will Grant sd petitioners, the privilege of their School Money, for a reason, set forth, in sd petition reference thereto being had, — Do or act &c —
- 9th To See, if the Town, will attend to a memorial from the Town of Marlborough, against sd town, for the support of Bezahel Moore, — reference being had to sd memorial Do or act, &c —
- 10th To See, if the Town, will Lay out a road, from Elijah Bacons House, (Leading through Jonas Hunts and William Hunts Land) to Landham road, agreeable to the Request of Elijah Bacon, and Jonas Hunt Do or act &c;
- 11th To See, if the Town, will grant a Sum of Money, for Enabling their Committee, to prosecute those persons, who have Violated the Law, by Inoculating for the small pox In sd Town, — Do or act — &c —
- 12th To See, if the Town, will Discontinue a road Nighett's Dix's House, — agreeable to sd Dix's Request, Do or act &c
- 13th To See, if the Town, will appropriate the remainder of the Grammar School money, due to the North west District to the use of a Reading and writing School, agreeable to the Request of Mamar Rice, — Do or act, &c —
