

April, Anno Domini 1793

These are to certify and warn all the Freeholders and other Inhabitants of the town of Sudbury. Qualified as is provided in the Constitution of this Commonwealth, to vote, in the choice of a Governor, Lt. Governor, and Senators, for the year ensuing, and all Others Qualified as the Law directs, to vote in town affairs, to meet at the Meeting House in S.^d town, on Monday the 1st day of April Next, at 1 o'clock in the afternoon on S.^d day, there & there, on

Art. 1st To bring in their votes, for a Governor, Lt. Governor & Senators, for the year ensuing.

2^d To choose a Moderator, and act upon the 6th 7th 11th & 12th articles, in the warning of March Meetings put over to April meeting, for further Consideration.

3^d To fill up vacancies, in those ~~town~~ Offices which the Law Requires, Should any office, appear to be vacant

4th To see if the town, agreeable to the petition of Henry Smith and others, will grant S.^d petitioners, the privilege, of their School-Money, for a ^{Reason} set forth in S.^d petition. Reference thereto being had. Do or Act, as the town shall think proper when Met.

5th To see if the town, will come into some Suitable Measures, for the raising this towns part, of the Short and Long Causeways, in Sudbury and East Sudbury. Agreeable to the Request, of Aaron Johnson. Do or act &c.

6th To see if the town will discontinue, or, Curb Lancaster old Road, Nigh M^r Dix's House, agreeable to S.^d Dix's Request. Do or Act &c.

7th To see if the town will appropriate the Remainder of the Grammar School-Money, due to the North west district to the use of a Reading and writing School, Agreeable to the Request of Thanner Rice. Do or act. &c.

8th To see if the town will grant a sum of Money, for the purpose of Building a School-House, in the Centre District, and appropriate the old school house, towards the erecting a New one, agreeable to the Request of Aaron Johnson and others. Do or act. &c.
