

May Anno Domini 1793

- 1st To Elect, or Depute, some Suitable person, being a Freeholder, & Resident, in S^d town to serve for, & Represent, said town, in a Great & General Court, appointed to be convened, held, & kept, for the service of this Commonwealth, at the State House, in Boston, On Wednesday the 29th Day of May Next, agreeable to a Law, of the Commonwealth, In that Case, made & provided.
- 2^d To Choose a Moderator, & act upon the 9th Art. in the Warning of April Meeting, & Refer^d to May Meeting, for further consideration.
- 3^d To see, if the town, will Discharge, M^r. James Thompson, a former Treas^r, a Certain Sum of Money, that he stands Charg^d with, agreeable, to S^d Thompsons Request, Do, or act, as the town shall think proper, when Met.
- 4th To see, if the town, will take any Measures, Respecting the Removal, of paupers Bachel^r & Children, from the Town of Northborough. Do or act, &c.
- 5th To see, if the town, will direct, Voth^r. Justs, their Late Treas^r, to Deliver to the Selectmen, a Receipt, signed by Col^l. Rice, for Jacob Holmes Note of hand, in Order, that the S^d Selectmen, may come to a Settlement, with S^d Rice, with Respect to the widow Mary Goodenows Legacy.
- 6th To see, if the town, will take any Measures, Respecting some town Orders, now, in the hands of L^t. Asher Cutler Do or act &c.
